RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT Breaux Bridge Crawfish Festival Parade

IN CONSIDERATION of being permitted to participate in the **Breaux Bridge Crawfish Festival Parade** and/or other activities relating to the Parade in Breaux Bridge, Louisiana (hereinafter referred to as the "Parade"), I, for myself, my organization, my fellow members of this organization, and their employees, agents, successors, assigns, heirs and next of kin: (hereinafter referred to as the "Parade Entry").

- 1. HEREBY RELEASE, WAIVE, DISCHARGE AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE the Parade, the Breaux Bridge Crawfish Festival Association, the City of Breaux Bridge, the Parade committee, Parade Sponsors and/or all Parade participants and the directors, officers, employees or agents of any of the foregoing (hereinafter referred to as "Releasees"), from all liability to me, my personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin for any and all loss or damage, and any claim or demands therefore on account of injury to my person or property or resulting in death, whether caused by the negligence of the Releasees or otherwise while I am observing, working for or participating in the Parade (including, but not limited to, all preparations therefore, the Parade itself, all incidental activities including pre-parade and post Parade activities, and the return of Parade materials to storage locations);

HEREBY AGREE TO INDEMNIFY AND SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS the Releasees and each of them from any loss, liability, damage, or costs they may incur due to my presence in any way observing, or working for, or participating in the Parade (including, but not limited to, all preparation therefore, the Parade itself, all incidental activities including pre-parade and post-parade activities, and the return of Parade materials to storage locations), and whether caused by the negligence of the Releasees or otherwise;

HEREBY ASSUME FULL REPONSIBILITY FOR ANY RISK OF BODILY HARM, DEATH OR PROPERTY DAMAGE due to the negligence of Releasees or other wise while observing, or working for, or participating in the Parade (including but not limited to, all preparation therefore, the Parade itself, all incidental activities including pre-parade and post-parade activities, and the return of Parade materials to storage locations).
